Region 8 Engineer of the Year (Five Categories)

2. Contribution to community, society and humanity
3. Contribution to the promotion of civil engineering profession including mentoring
4. Member of ASCE within Region 8 in good standing

Project of the Year completed in 2014 (>\$10 million)

1. A private or a public sector project with a total constructed value greater than \$10 million or a research project that contributes to civil engineering technology
2. Improves or has the potential to improve the quality of life of people impacted by the project
3. Contributes to the economic development of the profession, area or region
4. Is environmentally very responsible incorporating the principle of sustainable development
5. Recognizes the contributions of many engineers

Project of the Year completed in 2014 (<\$10 million)

1. A private or a public sector project with a total constructed value less than \$10 million or a research project that contributes to civil engineering technology
2. Improves or has the potential to improve the quality of life of people impacted by the project
3. Contributes to the economic development of the area
4. Is environmentally very responsible incorporating the principles of "sustainable development"

- Foster expanded public recognition of civil engineering achievements
