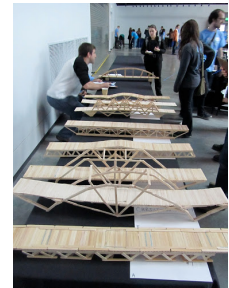
This event is the first of six mentor nights; keep an eye out for upcoming dates and locations in future announcements!
